## Aryan's perseverance pays off !

In the face of adversity, some children can be a beacon of hope for others. Aryan Rahate, a 16-year-old Grade X student studying in Parle Tilak Vidyalaya ICSE suffering from Leukaemia, inspired many by scoring 96.4% in the ICSE Grade X Board examinations 2023.

Besides being a good singer and student, he was the school Football team captain. Before his exams, due to his ongoing treatment, Aryan missed school, and there was a possibility that he would also miss his board exams which were to commence on February 28.

There are two choices to be made when we are all faced with challenges at some point in our life – adopt the attitude that there is nothing you can do or see the challenge as your call to action. Aryan chose the path less travelled. Though he had missed a significant portion of his studies, he decided to appear for the examinations. The school was informed well in advance about his health. The school Principal, Dr Mrs Arnavaz Bhagat, had notified the ICSE Council, and special arrangements were already made for Aryan. The school also extended the deadline for submitting his projects and assignments. The teachers were very understanding and compassionate towards Aryan's situation and provided additional help and guidance to him whenever he needed it.

On February 20, 2023, his second MRD test results came negative, and he had gone into complete remission. This showed that he was moving towards recovery, but Aryan would have to undertake chemotherapy sessions during the board exams. The management and the school Principal gave all possible support so that Aryan could appear for all his board papers from the school-isolated centre or the hospital.

At the time of board exams in March 2023, he was still undergoing treatment and was frequently hospitalised for Chemotherapy sessions. Aryan attempted three of his papers from the ICU unit of the hospital, where he was getting continuous Chemotherapy infusion. A special car was arranged to transport the special Chief Supervising Examiner, the Invigilator and the reader cum writer to adhere to the guidelines stated by the ICSE Council to avoid any malpractices irrespective of the given situation. The school complied with all the rules and regulations without compromising Aryan's comfort.

Aryan Rahate's achievement is a testament to overcoming any obstacle with hard work, dedication, and a positive mindset.

during your preparation?

**Poorva:** I read all the textbooks thoroughly and consistently. Because of this, I was familiar with the portion like the back of my hand by the end of the year. Sometimes, you do not have clarity even by keeping the book in front of you for hours. But you can get great clarity if you focus properly, even for an hour.

**Ayush:** Did you attend any coaching classes or rely only on self-study?

**Poorva:** I have practised self-study since the beginning. I studied only from the textbooks. I did not use any guides. My preparation was based on the textbooks, notes provided in school, and everything the teachers taught. They were very helpful, and I could ask them for any doubts or queries.

**Ayush:** How did you keep yourself motivated during the preparation?

**Poorva:** My 10th standard preparation did not start in April. It began in June, along with the school. I had a long vacation in May. When I started to study, I did it with focus. My co-curricular activities helped in driving away boredom. When I studied, it may not have been for many hours. It was qualitative studying than quantitative. When I scored well in the school exams, I felt motivated to perform better each time.

**Ayush:** How did you manage the exam pressure?

**Poorva:** Even I wasn't immune to it (pressure). Studying regularly and giving the school exams gave me an insight into the paper pattern and time management, which are essential in the exam. Instead of rote learning, learning with understanding helps. Most importantly, don't compare your efforts with those of others. In the end, all that matters is your progress.

**Ayush:** What are the factors that have contributed to your stupendous success?

**Poorva:** My parents and my family were very supportive. They always told me my marks didn't matter, but I should work hard to score well in the exam. They also reminded me that scoring well in the prelims and terminal examinations didn't mean I knew everything, which kept me grounded. The efforts of

my school teachers are equally important in my success. I was able to study in a stress-free environment due to these factors.

**Ayush:** How did you balance your academics and other co-curricular activities during the preparation?

**Poorva:** My curricular and co-curricular activities had been planned so that I would get enough time for both. Too much of anything is unhealthy. One should not miss out on co-curricular activities, but at the same time, one shouldn't lag in academics. It is necessary to balance the two to get a good result.

**Ayush:** How did you spend your leisure time in the last academic year? Tell us more about your hobbies and other interests.

**Poorva:** I spent my leisure time reading novels, playing badminton and practising dance. Dancing, reading, playing and chatting with my friends are some things that I enjoy doing. I also like to paint sometimes, but I'm not great at it. It is one of the things I would like to improve upon.

**Ayush:** What are your plans for the future in terms of education and career?

**Poorva:** I have given much thought to this over the past year. I have decided to opt for the science stream. My interest is in Biology and its related fields. I have decided to prepare for the NEET Entrance Exam in the next two years.

**Ayush:** Do you have any advice for the students who aspire to excel in the forthcoming SSC examination?

**Poorva:** Yes, my advice is to read the textbooks thoroughly. Analyse your mistakes and try to improve in those areas. Most importantly, be confident and have faith in yourself, your teachers and your efforts. Don't compare your progress with others. Take utmost care of your health. Sleep at least for 7 hours every night. Avoid pulling all-nighters for studying, as it affects your attention span during the day. It is also better to keep your phone in another room while studying because it is the biggest distraction. I am sure you will score well in your SSC Exams, and all your efforts will pay off!

## PTVA's teacher's work goes places !

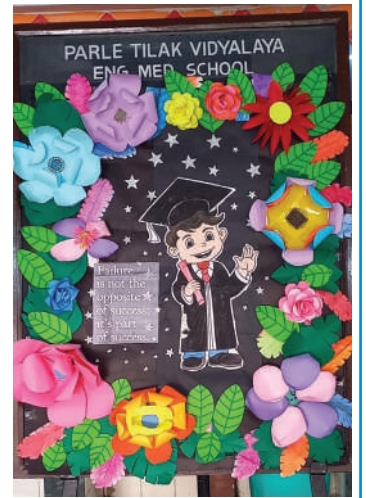
